Inflammation and your Health

Medical research continues to make connections between inflammation and several diseases. Often, chronic inflammation sets the stage for diseases affecting a growing number of people. Some forms of inflammation produce pain and swelling as with periodontal disease and arthritis. Other forms of inflammation remain undetectable by patient and doctor until a medical event occurs as with cardiovascular disease and diabetes. Products of inflammatory reactions damage cellular DNA leading to the formation of cancerous tumors. More recently, research suggests the brain can be affected by chronic inflammation leading to Alzheimers disease. Though each person has individual genetic predisposition for inflammatory disorders, there are known contributing factors. These include a diet high in sugar, breads, pasta, saturated fat and trans fat, omega 6, MSG, gluten and casein, aspartame and alcohol. Lack of sleep, stress and a sedentary lifestyle also feed the inflammatory process. By recognizing the role of chronic inflammation in producing disease, changes can be made to reduce risk factors and preserve quality of life. Prosthodontics: Prosthodontics is the dental specialty pertaining to the treatment of dental and facial problems that involve restoring missing teeth and jaw structures. Our prosthodontists are highly trained in cosmetics, dental implants, crowns, bridges, dentures, and temperomandibular joint (TMJ) disorders. Our maxillofacial prosthodontists, Dr. Vergo an Dr. Cagino, are specially trained in difficult full and partial dentures as well as patients with defects of the head and neck region due to cancer, surgery or trauma. **Conventional Dentures & Partial Dentures** have been a staple for many years for multiple teeth replacement. When fabricated by a Prosthodontist these *removable appliances* can function and feel like real teeth. An alternative to a removable appliance is a *fixed appliance*, using dental implant technology. Fixed appliances are secured by *dental implants*, are comfortable and can only be removed by your Prosthodontist. Our prosthodontists, Dr. Vincent Mariano and Dr. Alissa Mariano, are specially trained in prosthetically driven implant therapy and their restoration. Success rates of dental implants have risen due to 3D imaging/ CT scan capabilities. This advanced imaging software allows doctors to plan surgical procedures & determines if additional procedures will be needed such as bone grafting, sinus lifting or tissue repositioning. In general, dental implants have a success rate of up to 98%, with proper care implants can last a lifetime. There are a wide variety of uses for dental implants, a consultation with one of our Prosthodontists will determine if you are a good candidate.
